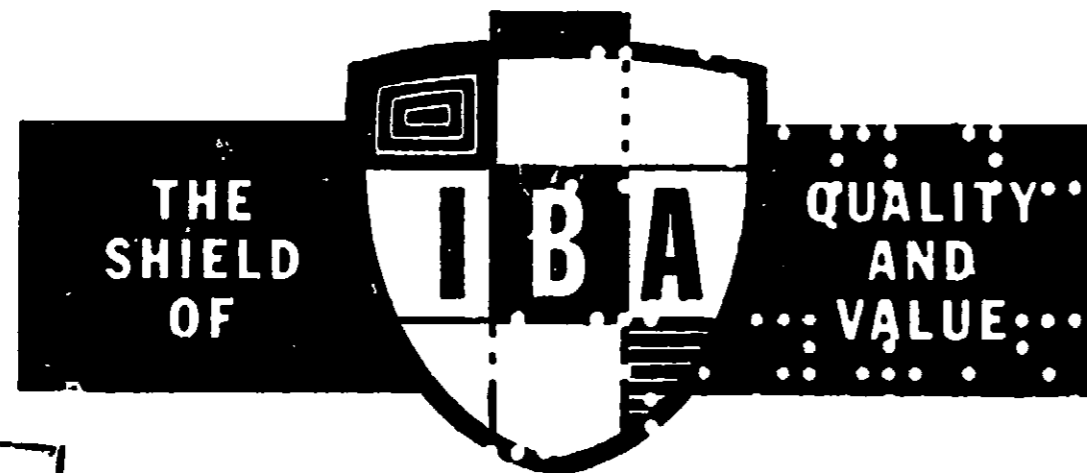

# RESIDUAL FLY SPRAY

4-6 Week Residual Fly Control

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

I.B.A. RESIDUAL FLY SPRAY is to be mixed with water to make a 1% solution to be applied to Farm Buildings including Poultry Houses, Livestock Shelters, Milk Rooms, Dairy and Hog Barns for 4 to 6 week Fly Control.

To make a 1% solution mix 1 quart of I.B.A. RESIDUAL FLY SPRAY with 6 gallons of water. Add 3 ounces of sugar for added effectiveness.

Use 1 gallon of diluted spray per 500-1000 sq. ft. Spray Walls, Ceilings, Partitions to obtain complete coverage with no run off. To prevent contamination, keep milk and milking equipment covered while spraying.

For Caged Layers on Wire, mix 1 quart with 3 gallons of water; spray poultry droppings beneath cages.

As a Livestock Insect Spray, dilute with water only. Spray entire animal to wet coat thoroughly. Repeat as necessary but not oftener than every 2 weeks.

**HOGS:** To control Lice, use 1 quart with 25 gallons of water.

**CATTLE, CALVES:** To control Hornflies, use 1 quart with 12 1/2 gallons of water. To control Lice, use 1 quart with 25 gallons of water. To control Lone Star Ticks and Winter Ticks, use 1 quart with 8 gallons of water.

**SHEEP, GOATS, LAMBS and KIDS:** To control Wool Maggots, Hornflies, use 1 quart with 12 1/2 gallons of water. To control Lice and Sheep Keds, use 1 quart with 25 gallons of water.

For Cattle Backrubbers — for Hornflies and to aid in control of Face Flies if backrubbers are placed so animal can rub face. Mix 1 quart I.B.A. RESIDUAL FLY SPRAY with 7 gallons of diesel, or similar, oil. Saturate fibre; recharge as necessary. Do not mix with used motor oil.

**WARNING:** Do not use on animals receiving an organic phosphate treatment from any other source at the time of treatment.

**NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:** This material is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically. Atropine is an antidote.

**CAUTION: INJURIOUS TO EYES. IRRITATING TO THE SKIN AND EYES. HARMFUL IF SWALLOWED.** Do not get in the eyes. Avoid contact with skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist.
