DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To control Horn Flies, apply 2 ounces (4 tablespoons) per animal. Rub well on back and neck of each animal to insure that the material is worked down beneath the hair. Repeat application every 3 weeks if necessary.

To control Lice, make a thorough application on Swine, Sheep and Beef Cattle, work the dust into the hair. Repeat application as necessary.

CAUTION

Keep out of reach of children.

Harmful if swallowed.

Avoid prolonged breathing of dust.

Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin; wash thoroughly after using.

Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuff.

Do not contaminate water or feed troughs.

Do not apply to dairy cattle later than five hours before milking or during milking.
