DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a Violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To control lice on non-lactating Dairy Cattle, Swine, and Beef Cattle, treat animals thoroughly. Repeat application as necessary.

Do not apply to dairy animals during lactating or within 2 weeks of freshening. Do not apply to animals being furnished for slaughter.

To control Horn Flies, apply 2 oz. (4 Tablespoons) per animal. Rub well on back and neck of each animal to insure that the material is worked down beneath the hair. Repeat application every three weeks if necessary.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. STORAGE: Store unused material, in original container only, in a locked, dry, storage area out of reach of children and animals. Keep container tightly closed. DISPOSAL: Do not reuse container. Securely wrap in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
