DIRECTIONS FOR USE

ORNAMENTALS: Use 4 teaspoons of ROCKLAND FERBAM FUNGICIDE to each gallon of water or 4 oz. to 25 gallons of water. Use sufficient spray to provide thorough coverage for Black Spot and Rust of Roses; Septoria Leaf Spot and Rust of Chrysanthemums; Leaf Spot and Rust of Snapdragons; Bacterial Leaf Spot of Geraniums; Leaf Spot, Rust, Alternaria and Septoria Blights of Carnations; Leaf Spot and Botrytis Rot of Cyclamen; Botrytis Blight (tulip fire) of Tulips, Rust of Juniper, Leaf Spots of Aster, Begonia, Gardenia, Hydrangea, Ivy, and Laurel. Apply before disease becomes apparent and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals as needed. For Petal Blight of Azaleas and Camellias apply while buds are opening and repeat at 3 to 5 day intervals as needed; spray ground around plant thoroughly.
