

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water; for eyes, get medical attention. When handling this product, wear chemical resistant gloves.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:

This product is toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Drift or run-off may adversely affect aquatic invertebrates and nontarget plants. Do not apply directly to water or wetlands (swamps, bogs, marshes, and potholes). Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HANDLING PRECAUTIONS: When using this product, wear long sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes, and chemical resistant gloves. After using this product, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse, and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water.

Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treatment areas until dust has settled.

Apply **ROCKLAND PROFESSIONAL TRIPLE "D" LAWN WEED KILLER** at any time weeds are growing actively—Spring, Summer or Fall. Apply as it comes right from the bag. Not to be mixed with other chemicals. Measure off area to be treated. For the more difficult-to-kill weeds, a repeat application may have to be made about 3 weeks after initial treatment. For best results, mow lawn before applying and apply when grass is moist (from morning or evening dew). Set spreader to proper setting and apply. The maximum number of broadcast applications per treatment site is 2 per year.

SUGGESTED SPREADER SETTINGS:

Cyclone...3; Scott Rotary...B; Scott Drop...4-4½

Newly seeded lawns may be treated after they have been mowed at least twice. To re-seed small areas in treated lawns, wait at least 3 weeks after application. A good rain or deep watering should occur during this period.

PRECAUTIONS

Do not use **ROCKLAND PROFESSIONAL TRIPLE "D" LAWN WEED KILLER** for controlling weeds in flower or vegetable beds, shrubs, ornamental plantings, Lippia and Dichondra lawns. Do not apply during periods of drought unless the lawn is watered thoroughly several days before treatment. Do not apply within the drip line or root system of trees and shrubs. Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides. Do not use in a greenhouse. Avoid drift of dust to vegetables, flowers, ornamental shrubs, trees and other desirable crop plants. Do not use on centipede grass, St. Augustine grass nor on lawns where desirable bentgrass is present.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store unused material, in original container only, in a locked, dry storage area out of reach of children and animals. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide or waste, is a violation of Federal Law and may contaminate groundwater. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.
