 - Under this list, change field peas to green peas and delete blackeyed peas. Your list would then be consistent with those direct seeded vegetables shown on Elanco's registered product under #1471-65.
 - b. Delete the directions for Irish potatoes. You have not used directions consistent with those on the Elanco label.
3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

ONE EASY APPLICATION stops unwanted grasses (annual bluegrass, crabgrass, stinkgrass, goosegrass, barnyard grass, foxtail) and kills many broadleaf weed seeds (Chickweed, knotweed, pigweed, lambsquarters, smartweed, carpetweed, purslane) at sprouting. Will not harm established flowers, shrubs, and other plants. Do not apply to Ajuga, Myrtle, Pachysandra, and other ornamental ground-covers as injury may result.

This product may be applied to established evergreens, trees, shrubs, roses, and the following flowers: Ageratum, Aster, Balsam, Calendula, California Poppy, Calliopsis, Carnation, Cosmos, Dahlia, Forget-Me-Not, Four O'Clocks, Gaillardia, Gladiolus, Hollyhock, Lobelia, Marigold, Morning Glory, Nasturtium, Pet-winkle, Petunia, Portulaca, Shasta Daisy, Snapdragon, Stocks, Sunflower, Sweet Alyssum, Sweet Pea, Zinnia.

This product may also be applied to the following vegetables:

WHEN TO USE: Apply in the spring around shrubbery and in flower beds containing established plants. Apply before grass and weed seeds begin to sprout. May be applied up to 10 weeks before planting direct seeded vegetables.

HOW TO USE: This product will control grass and weeds only where applied. Therefore, even application (no skips or misses) is important. For best results, use as follows:

1. Before applying, remove all existing grasses and weeds as this product kills sprouting seeds but no established plants.
2. At application, work into the soil with a tool or implement that breaks up large clods and distributes the chemical within the top 2 to 3 inches of the final seedbed. The more thoroughly Garden Clean is mixed within the soil, the more consistent the weed control.
