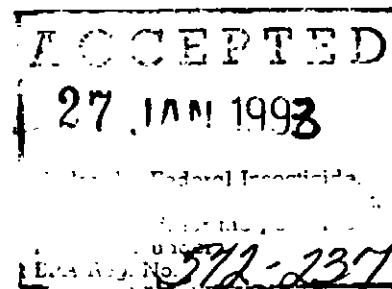

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.
IF ON SKIN: Wash exposed areas with soap and water.
IF SWALLOWED: DO NOT induce vomiting. If vomiting occurs spontaneously, keep airways clear. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Seek medical attention immediately.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.
USE ONLY WHEN WEARING THE FOLLOWING PROTECTIVE CLOTHING: Wear long sleeved shirt and long legged pants and chemical resistant gloves.
IMPORTANT! If the pesticide comes in contact with skin, wash off with soap and water. Always wash hands, face, and arms with soap and water before smoking, eating, drinking, or toileting.
AFTER USE: Before removing gloves, wash them with soap and water. Take off all work clothes and shoes. Shower using soap and water. Do not reuse contaminated clothing. Clothing worn during use must be laundered separately from household articles.
Apply in Spring or just before expected germination of weed seeds at 3.5 lb per 1000 square feet. At least 1/2 inch of water must be provided by lawn watering within a week after application.
Use only on turf areas. Do not reseed within 60 days after treatment. Newly seeded lawns should exhibit greening from newly-sprouted turfgrass before treatment. Do not apply to Dichondra. Do not use on Cohansy or Toronto Bents. Do not use on Buffon pink, Carnation, Germander, Mesembryanthemum, Pansy, Phlox, Sweet William and Telanthera.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
