Your Application Dated November 26, 1985

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable, provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Lowercase all but initial letter of Dimethyl in the first active ingredient.
2. Declare second active ingredient as Mineral oil.
3. Change "READ DIRECTIONS AND WARNING BEFORE USE" to "SEE ADDITIONAL PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS ON SIDE PANEL."
4. Delete "PROLONGED or REPEATED" in the precautionary statement.
5. A Statement of Practical Treatment must be added to the labeling. We suggest the following statement; however, if your toxicological data suggest otherwise, please submit a draft Statement of Practical Treatment for prior approval:

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

- If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.
- If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

6. Revise the Note to Physician to read: Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be used in conjunction with atropine.
7. Add block

Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not apply directly to any body of water. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Use only as specified on this label.

8. Add directions to go with statement "Adjust and charge oilers as directed."

FOR LACTATING COWS AND DAIRY HEIFERS: Place backrubbers and facerubbers strategically around the pasture and/or loafing areas especially near feed bunks or watering facilities. Adjust and charge oilers as directed. Recharge as needed.

FOR BEEF CATTLE ON PASTURE OR RANGE OR IN FEEDLOT: Place backrubbers and facerubbers in areas frequently visited by the cattle. Adjust and charge oilers as directed. Recharge as needed. Rockland BACKRUBBER OIL can be used up to time of slaughter.
