At 11/2 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. for prevention of diseases above. Apply at 7-10 day intervals. At 21/2 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. for control and prevention during periods when conditions favor disease (warm humid weather). It may also be desirable to apply at shorter intervals of 7 days each. During periods of no rais and dry conditions, water lawn or turf at rate of 10 gallons per 1,000 sq. ft. before application.

For control of snow mold, apply 21/2 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. Make first application in the fall after the first killing frost. A second application should be made when the lawn is free of snow in mid-winter and a third after the final melting of snow in late winter or early spring. CYCLONE SPREADER SETTINGS:
