A 2,4-D and Silvex (2,4,5-TP) coated corn cob for killing Dandelion, Chickweed, Clover, Plantain, Buckhorn and other broad leaf weeds. Manufactured specifically for use in Cyclone-type spreaders.

Broadleaf weeds in lawns are best controlled when they are actively growing in Spring or Fall.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Spread evenly at the rate of 2 pounds per 1000 sq. ft. Apply on a calm day when grass is wet with dew, or after watering. For Clover a repeat application may be required in two weeks.

Do not mow or water lawn 24 hours after application. Do not apply on new lawns less than two months old. Do not re-seed for 30 days after application.

SPREADER SETTING: CYCLONE 3 ..

CAUTION: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid drift to susceptible plants or flowers. Do not store near fertilizers, insecticides or fungicides. Do not use on any area growing desirable shrubs, tree, ornamentals or other cultivated plants. Do not contaminate waters used for domestic or irrigational purposes.
