A Balan-coated corn cob for pre-emergence control of crabgrass and annual blue grass in established lawns.

**DIRECTION FOR USE**

LAWN and ORNAMENTAL TURFS (established turf only):

Apply at rate of 2 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. of lawn with a spreader for the control of Smooth and Hairy Crabgrass, Goosegrass (Silver Crabgrass), Barnyardgrass, Yellow and Green Foxtail and Annual Bluegrass (Poa Annua). This product controls weeds by killing their seeds as they germinate. It does not control established weeds. Time application in the Spring before the germination of annual grass weeds listed. Water after application to wash chemical into the turf.

SPREADER SETTING: CYCLONE 3.

PRECAUTION: Do not apply in the Spring to completely new lawns started the previous Fall. Do not apply to bentgrass putting greens or dichondra turf. Do not apply to newly sprigged areas of Bermudagrass, St. Augustinegrass or Centipedegrass until these turfs are well established since root inhibition may result. Do not reseed within 42 days after treatment.
