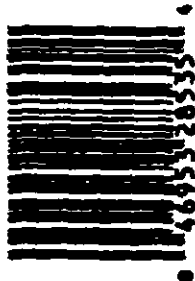

To control insects named, apply this spray as a mist (adjust nozzle by turning in order to deliver a fine mist) to thoroughly cover upper and lower leaf surfaces. Repeat treatments weekly or as needed to control infestations. May be applied on day of harvest. Do not spray when temperatures exceed 90°F.
