The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below:

1. The request to delete the greenhouse use is acceptable. The request published in the Federal Register on November 30, 1994.
2. In the "Precautionary Statements" section, changed "ENVIRONMENTAL CAUTIONS:" to "ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:". Also, the sentence that begins with "Do not contaminate water by . . ." should read as follows: "Do not contaminate water by disposing of equipment washwaters."
3. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. This insecticide may be used on indoor and outdoor plants throughout the growing season, or as a preharvest treatment when other insecticides are prohibited due to residue restrictions and use limitations.

To control insects named, apply this spray as a mist (adjust nozzle by turning in order to deliver a fine mist) to thoroughly cover upper and lower leaf surfaces. Repeat treatments weekly or as needed to control infestations. May be applied on day of harvest. Do not spray when temperature exceeds 90°F.

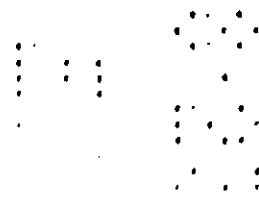
