STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention.
IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and water. Launder clothes before reusing. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air away from contaminated area.

ROCKLAND WEED AND GRASS KILLER is for non-selective weed and grass control in Driveways, Patios, along Fence Rows and Industrial Sites where a weed-free soft surface is desired. This product kills most young weeds and grasses on contact and deposits a chemical residue on the soil. This residue controls annual weeds and grass seedlings from germinating during the entire growing season. Contact activity will be apparent in a few days. Final kill by root penetration may take from 2 to 3 weeks.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For best results

apply in early Spring before weeds germinate. If weeds have germinated, apply before they are 4 inches tall. During seasons of unusually high rainfall a second application may be necessary.

For Walks, Driveways, Patios, Tennis Courts and Graveled Areas: Mix 1 quart WEED & GRASS KILLER with 2 gallons of water and apply over 250 sq. ft. Use a sprinkling can or sprayer to thoroughly wet all foliage.

For areas where heavy grass and weed growth is present in such as Fence Rows and Fire Lanes and where vegetation is more than 24 inches high, mow or cut to 8 inch height before applying. Apply 1 quart in 5 to 8 gallons of water per 250 sq. ft. To control deep rooted perennial weeds such as Milkweed and Canada Thistle a second application in 2 to 3 months may be necessary.

CAUTION: Do not use this product on lawns. Do not use close to desirable flower beds. Do not apply over root zones of valuable trees, shrubs or woody ornamental plants. Apply this material outside the drip line of trees and shrubs. Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides. Avoid spray drift to susceptible plants as this product may injure cotton, beans, peas, grapes, ornamentals, etc. (Coarse sprays are less likely to drift.) Vapors from this product may injure susceptible plants in the immediate vicinity.

CLEANING EQUIPMENT: Wash sprinkling can or sprayer thoroughly with household detergent and water immediately after use. Rinse well with clean water.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL (12 pt. type)

STORAGE: Store unused material, in original container only, in a locked, dry storage area out of reach of children and animals. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not store near fertilizer, seeds or other pesticides. Keep from freezing.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticides, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest E.P.A.
