PREPLANT SOIL APPLICATION: Apply at least 1 pint per planting at the following rates per 1000 sq. ft. in sufficient water to achieve thorough coverage and immediately water in. Cutworms: 6 fl. oz. (Surface Cutworms: 2 in. Subterra near Cutworms: 3.6 in.) (Garden) by cutworm (Subterra: Centipedes): 15 fl. oz. work in 4.8 in. R. Maggots: Cabbage ONLY: 4.2 fl. oz. work in 3.4 in. Wireworms: Cabbage: Cutworm: Cabbage: Lettuce: Pear: Snap: Beans: and Tomatoes ONLY: 5 fl. oz. work in 4.8 in.

OUTDOOR AREA NUISANCE PESTS: Mix 6 fl. oz. in 1.5 gallons of water. Thoroughly spray window frames, doors, screens, porches, patio walls, foundations, leaks, garbage cans and in cracks and other places where insects may hide for cockroaches, ants, cockroaches, boxelder bugs, clover mites, spiders, ticks, chiggers and earwigs. Do not treat plants with this dilution rate.

FLORAL, SHRUB and SHADE TREE SPRAY: Mix 1.5 oz. in 1 gallon of water (8 fl. oz. in 24 gal.) to control Aphids, Mites, Leafhoppers, Thrips, Leafminers and Scale Crawlers on Roses, Azaleas, Chrysanthemums, Garden Carnations, Oaks, Maple, Elm, Holly, Boxwood, Pine, Spruce, Willow. Penetrate dense foliage to thoroughly cover all plant surfaces. Do not use on certain Ferns, Poinsettia, Hibiscus, Papaya, Pilea and Gardenia since injury to the plants may occur.

FRUIT SPRAY: Mix 1.5 oz. in 24 gal. of water to control Codling Moths, Mites, Aphids, Leafhoppers and braconid wasps on Apples, Peaches, Plums, Grapes, Cherries and Strawberries. Start spraying after bloom and repeat at 10-14 day intervals if needed. Do not spray within 21 days of picking.

VEGETABLE SPRAY: Mix 2 Tablespoons (1 fl. oz.) in 3 gal. of water (8 fl. oz. in 24 gal.). Three gallons of diluted spray will cover 1000 sq. ft. of Tomatoes, Carrots, Potatoes, Beans, Cucumbers, Chins, Calfarnpes, Peppers and Cabbage. Control Bean Beetles, Aphids, Leafminers, imported Cutworms and Cucumber Beetles. Make applications at 7-10 day intervals and when insects appear. Do not spray in 10 days prior to and 35 days for Potatoes. 1 day for Tomatoes. Wash home garden vegetables before using.
