STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious (or convulsing) person. NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric Lavage may be indicated if product was taken internally. Diazinon is an organophosphate insecticide. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-Pam is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash affected areas with soap and water. Launder clothing before reuse.

IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call physician at once.
