PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS:

Harmful if swallowed. Do not get on skin or in eyes. Do not breathe dust. Keep away from food, feedstuffs and domestic water supplies. Keep children and pets off treated areas until this material is washed into the soil and grass is dry. Wash contaminated clothing before re-use.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed: Call a physician at once. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching finger to back of throat. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsive person.

If in eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water and get medical attention if irritation persists.

If on skin: Wash contaminated skin with soap and plenty of water.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Active ingredient is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Treat symptomatically, Atropine by injection only, is an antidote.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: PROHIBITIONS: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Completely empty bag by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Fertilize and control ANTS, BROWN DOG TICKS, CHINCH BUGS, CRICKETS, CUTWORMS, EARWIGS, HYPERODES (TURFGRASS) WEEVILS, SOD WEBWORMS (LAWN MOTHS), SOW BUGS in one operation. This Fertilizer, with Dursban® Insecticide, combines the highest quality ingredients available on a uniform corn cob base to give equal distribution of all particles over lawn area for uniform growth, and is non-burning when used as directed. Do not apply this material during periods of hot, dry weather.

For control of ANTS, BROWN DOG TICKS, CHINCH BUGS, CRICKETS, CUTWORMS, EARWIGS, SOD WEBWORMS, SOW BUGS, spread evenly at the rate of 1 pound per 1000 square feet. Water lawn using 30 gallons per 1000 square feet, after application. For Chinch Bugs in New Jersey-New York metropolitan area, make first application in June. In other areas consult your local state agricultural extension agent as to the exact timing.

SPREADER SETTINGS: Cyclone 3; Scott Drop 4; Scott Rotary B.

For control of HYPERODES WEEVIL, apply as above except at twice the rate, or 2 pounds per 1000 sq. ft. Apply over suspected problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May.

HYPERODES WEEVIL SPREADER SETTINGS: Cyclone 4½; Scott Drop 6½-7; Scott Rotary M-N.
