ROCKLAND THREE WAY Lawn Weed Killer is effective for the control of dandelion, chicory, clover, dock, dog fennel, English daisy, French weed, knotweed erect, knotweed prostrate, ground ivy, hawkweed, healall, henbit, lambsquarter, mallow, morning glory, chickweed (mouse ear-commonstitchwort), mustard, oxalis, pennywort, peppergrass, pigweed, plantain, poison ivy, poison oak, Canada thistle, burdock, jimson weed, purselane, ragweed, smartweed, sheep sorrell, spotted spurge,

wild aster, wild carrot, wild garlic, wild onion, wild radish, wood sorrel, and many other broadleaf weeds.

**IMPORTANT:** Do not use this product for controlling weeds in flower or vegetable beds or around shrubs or ornamental plantings. Do not reseed for 3 to 4 weeks after use. If lawn needs watering, water thoroughly before application. Do not water for 48 hours after application. Spray entire lawn, wetting weeds and lawn grasses; do not overspray. Spray when air is calm to avoid spray drift that might injure desirable ornamental plants. Do not apply when temperatures are expected to exceed 85° within 24 hours following application. Make new dilution for each use.

**NEWLY SEEDED LAWNS** - May be treated after they have been mowed at least 3 times. **BENT, BERMUDA, RED FESCUE, CENTIPEDE AND CARPET GRASSES** - Use one-half recommended rate (2 tsp. of this product per gal. water covers 200 sq. ft.). Temporary injury may occur. Make 2 applications 10 days apart. do not apply to Dichondra, Lippia, St. Augustine and Clover lawns.

**LAWN WEEDS** - To kill dandelion, wild onion, pennywort, plantain, healall and similar weeds: Use 8 oz. in 6 gal. of water and apply with pump or hose-end sprayer, or sprinkling can to 2,500 sq. ft. of lawn. (For smaller areas use 2 tsp. in 2 quarts of water applied to 100 sq. ft.) For larger areas use 1 gal. in 50 gals. of water to 1 acre.

To kill weeds such as thistles, bindweed, dock and ragweed, use 8 oz. in 6 gals of water (or 2 tsp. in 2 qts of water), and apply directly to plants, wetting them thoroughly. Repeat as necessary. For larger areas use 1 gal. in 50 gals. of water.

To kill undesirable plants such as poison ivy and poison oak, use 8 tsp. in 2 qts water or 1 gal. in 12½ gals. of water and drench plants when they are fully leaved. Repeat in about 4 weeks if necessary. Certain hard-to-kill weeds such as poison ivy, poison oak and English daisy may require a fall application.

**IMPORTANT:** Avoid drift spray (Coarse sprays are less likely to drift) on vegetables, flowers, ornamental shrubs, trees and other desirable crop plants. Do not pour solution used to clean sprayer near desirable plants.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuff, fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides. Store in a cool, dry, locked storage area. Do not store diluted spray. Keep out of reach of children.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL:(For containers over 1 gallon: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
