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the stem lightly to a point slightly higher than the cuiting to be set in the sand or other medium. To remove excess powder, tap on the edge of the container.

Hormo-Root powders are light and usually go further than other preparations. One pound should treat 35 to 40,000 average cuttings.

When using Hormo-Root powder it is desirable to have bottom heat preferably between 70-75 F. Treated cuttings should not have less than a 60 F temperature. Any rooting medium may be used but a mixture of sand and peat has been found very satisfactory for most vegetative reproduction. **STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store in tightly closed container in a dry, cool, dark, locked area away from children and domestic animals. For disposal, securely wrap closed container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not reuse container.
