DIFFICULT TO ROOT

Smooth stemmed cuttings before dipping in the powder. Dip stem lightly to a point slightly set in the sand or other medium. Tap on the edge of the container.

Hormo-Root powders are lighter than other preparations. One pound covers 1000 average cuttings.

When using Hormo-Root powder, bottom heat preferably between 65-75°F. A propagation medium may be used but a medium found very satisfactory for most species.
