

To control Stable Flies, Horse Flies, Dear Flies, apply 2 ounces per adult animal, sufficient to wet the hair, but not to soak the hide. Repeat treatment once or twice daily or at intervals necessary to give continued protection.

To Control Blood-Sucking Lice, apply the spray lightly to infested areas, using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. Use 2 ounces or less per animal. Repeat every two to three weeks as required.
