


Cuprinol Clear Wood Preservative No. 20 is for use on bare wood above ground level to protect against rot, mildew, warping and swelling. It contains an effective fungistat (zinc naphthenate). Cuprinol preservative is not a varnish, stain, or sealer. It will not crack, chip, blister or peel. Cuprinol penetrates to protect wood against mildew, watermarking and other water damage while still letting your wood weather naturally. This weathering process can produce graying and contrasting wood tones, depending upon the type of wood and its exposure. Use it on all bare wood outside, above ground line, and especially wood that is subject to dampness: house siding, sills, doors, door frames, windows, millwork, roofs, fences, decks.

Use Cuprinol Wood Preservative before you paint bare wood too.

It helps protect the wood and extends the life and beauty of paint by protecting against blistering, cracking and peeling caused by rain and dew. Allow 24 hours after application before painting with a good quality oil-based paint or primer; or 6-12 months before applying latex paint or clear finishes. See Direction For Use for more information.

The degree of weathering which results from different exposures is unpredictable. In some woods, specifically redwood and cedar, weathering may cause natural extractives to produce uneven shadings. To minimize extractive discoloration, apply a solution of 1 part oxalic acid and 3 parts water. Let it sit for half an hour. Then rinse with water; let dry and apply Cuprinol Wood Preservative.

This preservative should not be applied to a mildewed surface. Test for mildew by applying a 50-50 solution of bleach and water. Mildew is present if the area lightens. Spray all mildew-infected surfaces with a solution of 1 qt. household bleach and 3 Qts. warm water. Let stand for 30 minutes, then rinse with clear water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For Exterior Use Only This product must be applied out-of-doors to wood intended only for exterior use. DO NOT TRIM. Wood must be dry, free of bark, mildew and any finish. Apply by brush, spray or dip. THOROUGHLY cover cut ends. The more preservative absorbed by the wood, the longer and more effective the protection. Do not use more than two coats. Use only one thin coat before applying paint. Cuprinol No. 20 Clear dries in 24 to 36 hours on dry wood. For second coat application, apply within one hour of the first. When dipping, allow to soak for 3 minutes. We recommend that wood be re-treated within 3 years. Roofs should be retreated within 2 years. Areas subject to direct water contact, for example roof runoff, may require an earlier reapplication. On initial treatment of new wood siding two coats are recommended.

Coverage for this product ranges from 150-300 sq. ft. per gallon depending on wood porosity and surface texture.

Cleanup: Clean Cuprinol No. 20 Clear from brushes, etc. with mineral spirits, paint thinner or turpentine.

For protection below ground and for wood in contact with water, use Cuprinol[®] No. 19 Green Wood Preservative.

For protection of pressure treated lumber, use Cuprinol[®] Clear Wood Seal.

Use Cuprinol Revive[™] Easy Deck Cleaner to remove dirt, mildew and algae - leaving a fresh, natural look.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Avoid storage near food or food products.
DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Destroy it by perforating or crushing. Bury or discard in a safe place.
