DIRECTIONS

Haviland 7 M Dust should be applied at the rate of 15 to 30 lbs, per acre depending on the size and spacing of the plants and the method of application. In general, the lower rates are usually used early in the season and gradually increased as the foliage and plants increase in size with the higher rates being used later in the season as plants reach maturity.

BEANS — To control <u>Downy Mildew</u> and <u>Rust</u> — apply dust when disease first appears and repeat at weekly intervals. Do not apply to stringbeans within 4 days of harvest, no time limitation on dry beans.

CABBAGE, BRUSSEL SPROUTS, CAULIFLOWER, KOHLRABI and BROCCOLI — To control Downy Midew and Alternaria Leaf Spot begin dusting as soon as disease threatens and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals in the field. Use at 3 day intervals in plant beds. Remove residues by trimming and washing. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest on cabbage.

CARROTS— To control Leaf Blight and Cercospora Leaf Spot apply dust when diseases are reported in the area and continue at 7 to 10 day intervals during the growing season, or as required for adequate control.

CELERY — To control Early and Late Blight begin dusting in the plant bed when plants first come through the ground. Make futher applications at 3 to 5 day intervals until plants are set in the field. Continue field applications on regular weekly schedule. Remove residues by stripping, trimming and washing.

CANTALOUPE, CUCUMBER, SQUASH, MELONS and WATERMELONS

— To control Downy Mildew, Anthracnose and Gummy Stem Blight start dusting when runners begin to form or at the first sign of disease. Repeat at weekly intervals. Dusting of the underside of leaves is necessary for good control.

EGGPLANTS and **PFPPERS** — To control Fruit Rot and Anthracnose apply dust as fruit begins to form and repeat weekly until harvest.

ENDIVE, LETTUCE and SPINACH — To control Downy Mildew and White Rust apply dust at the first signs of disease and repeat at 7 to 10 day

intervals until harvest as required. Remove residues by trimming and washing. Do not use within 7 days of harvest.

TOMATOES — To control Early and Late Blight, Anthracnose, Stemphylium, Septoria Leaf Spot and Cladosporium Gray Mold on tomatoes in the field, greenhouse or plant beds begin dusting when disease is first reported in the area and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals or oftener during severe late blight conditions. Use at the rate of 40 lbs. per acre in severe anthracnose areas. To avoid damage, do not use on tenger young plants under glass.

ONIONS — To control Downy Mildew, Botrytis Leaf Blight and Purple Blotch apply dust when diseases are reported in the area and continue at 7 to 10 day intervals during the growing season.

POTATOES — To control Early and Late Blight apply dust at 7 to 10 days throughout the season. Begin applications early using the lower rate and increase amount per acre as vines increase in size.
