MIXING DIRECTIONS

While filling sprayer, the pump and agitator should be running. If a fungicide or insecticide is to be sprayed with spray oil, add these when sprayer is about ¼ full. When sprayer is ½ full after fungicide or insecticide has been thoroughly mixed, add proper amount of Haviland Superior Spray Oil.

Superior Spray Oils have been successfully combined with Thylate, Cyprex, Ferbam, Fixed Copper, B.H.C., Lindane, Guthion, Malathion, Trithion, Parathion, Kelthane and Tedion.

Be sure spray tank is clean and free from all Lime-sulfur or other sulfur deposits. Be certain that Haviland Superior Spray Oil is compatible with other insecticides or fungicides which might be used, either in the same spray tank or applied shortly after the oil application. Do not use Superior Spray Oil with or USE WITHIN 6 DAYS OF THE FOLLOWING SPRAY CHEMICALS: Captan, Dichlone, Sulfur, Limesulfur, Phaltan, Sevin, Karathane, Folpet, or any other material not proven to be compatible with Superior Spray Oils.
