DIRECTIONS

CUCUMBERS, MELONS AND SQUASH — To control Aphids, Leafhoppers, and Mites apply at the rate of 50 to 70 lbs. per acre when insects first appear and repeat as necessary. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest to Summer Squash or Cucumbers, nor within 3 days to Melons or Winter Squash.

ONIONS — To control Onion Thrips apply at the rate of 50 lbs. per acre when insects appear and repeat as necessary. Do not apply within 10 days of harvest.

TOMATOES — To control Aphids, Vinegar Flies (*Drosophila* sp.) and Dipterous Leafminers apply at the rate of 25 lbs. per acre. Begin when insects first appear and repeat at weekly intervals or as necessary. Do not apply within 3 days of harvest.

CABBAGE, CAULIFLOWER, AND BROCCOLI — To control Aphids, Diamondback Moths, and Imported Cabbageworms apply at the rate of 25 to 50 lbs. per acre. Begin when insects first appear and repeat as necessary. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest on Cabbage or 5 days on Cauliflower or Broccoli.

POTATOES — To control Aphids, Flea Beetles, and Colorado Potato Beetles, apply at the rate of 25 to 40 lbs. per acre. Begin when insects first appear and repeat as needed. Do not apply within 35 days of harvest.

APPLES — To control Codling Moths, Apple Maggots, Aphids, San Jose Scale crawlers, Forbes' Scale Crawlers, and mites apply at the rate of 50 lbs. per acre. Begin at the first cover spray and repeat at weekly intervals or as necessary. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.

CHERRIES — To control Black Cherry Aphids, Cherry Fruit Flies, and San Jose Scale Crawlers apply at the rate of 25 to 50 lbs. per acre. Begin application at petal fall and continue through cover applications. Do not apply within 10 days of harvest.

PEACHES — To control Aphids, Mites, and San Jose Scale Crawlers apply at the rate of 50 lbs. of dust per acre. Begin at petal fall and continue through cover applications. Do not apply within 20 days of harvest.

STRAWBERRIES — To control Aphids, and Mites apply at the rate of 25 to 50 lbs. per acre. Begin when pests appear and repeat as necessary. Dust should be directed into the crowns of the plants and the plants sufficiently agitated to insure thorough coverage. Do not apply within 5 days of harvest.

COCKROACH CONTROL — (By Pest Control Operators Only) For control of resistant and non-resistant cockroaches (waterbugs) dust thoroughly areas under and around dwellings and other buildings, around water pipes, cracks and crevices, behind and beneath cabins and areas where roaches crawl or hide. Treatments should be repeated as infestation warrants.

Care should be taken to avoid deposits which could be frequently contacted by children or pets. Do not contaminate food food containers or cooking utensils.
