

HOW TO USE PURINA INSECT OIL CONCENTRATE

OUTSIDE AREA SANITATION

To destroy unwanted vegetation which provides shelter for insects and rodents, and to aid in reducing the number of viable coccidial oöcyst and roundworm, *Ascarid*, eggs.

Dilution Mix one quart of Insect Oil Concentrate with 5 gallons of kerosene, fuel or diesel oil.

How to Apply Apply *diluted* oil with a sprinkling can or coarse sprayer at the rate of one gallon to 100-150 square feet. Treat an area 10 feet wide surrounding animal houses. Treat paths and roadways to control weeds and reduce tracking of parasite eggs.

Do not use in poultry houses.

AS A WOOD PRESERVATIVE:

Dilution Mix one quart of Insect Oil Concentrate with 2 gallons of oil. If the surfaces are to be painted, use kerosene or range oil. Where darker stain is preferred, use fuel or diesel oil.

How to Apply Pieces to be treated should be free of bark, dry and well seasoned. Heavy timbers, particularly those which are to contact the ground, such as posts, should be dipped for a period of 24 to 48 hours. Other

wood surfaces that are to come in contact with the ground should receive a minimum three-minute dip or two or more coats by spray or brush method. Proper application repels termites and powder post beetles and helps protect wood against rot.

WARNING: Do not spray on or near domestic animals or poultry. Do not use on crop lands. Purina Insect Oil Concentrate or ready-to-use solutions made from it contain volatile oils. Keep away from fires and exposed wires. Use adequate ventilation. Be sure that oil has soaked into the wood and is thoroughly dry and the building well ventilated. Do not get on skin, in eyes, or in food or feed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Do not get on clothing. Do not breathe vapor or spray mist. Wash thoroughly after handling. To remove from skin, wash with plenty of soap and warm water. If solution gets in the eyes, flood with water for 15 minutes; call a physician.
