Wet the dog thoroughly with lukewarm water. Apply a small amount of Dog Shampoo to various parts of the haircoat. Rub to produce abundant lather. Add more water if necessary to increase lathering.

To kill fleas, ticks, and lice, let lather remain in haircoat for five minutes. Work lather into outer ear if ticks are present. Rinse haircoat with clean water. Repeat as necessary.

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Figure 1 consists of a 4x4 grid of 16 small plots. Each plot represents the spatial distribution of a different species. The plots are arranged in four rows and four columns. The species are identified by numbers 1 through 16, which are placed to the right of each plot.
