

HOW TO USE PURINA BACK SCRATCH CONCENTRATE

Purina Back Scratch Concentrate will aid in controlling horn flies, lice, mosquitoes and gnats. Effectiveness of control will depend on number and location of rubbing devices, how often cattle and hogs use them, and proper maintenance. Back rubbing equipment should be located in areas where animals loaf, feed, or water. Regular exposure of the animals for about 10 weeks is usually necessary for satisfactory results against lice.

DIRECTIONS

Because uniform mixing cannot be done in most backscratch reservoirs—mix this product with oil in a separate container as follows:

Pour one quart of Purina Back Scratch Concentrate into a clean 5 gallon pail or can containing 4 gallons of No. 2 fuel oil or diesel fuel oil. If a heavier weight oil is desired, use a light paraffin oil either alone or in combination with No. 2 fuel oil. Mix by stirring thoroughly. Pour mixed solution into oil reservoir or apply to burlap, rope, or canvas covering until saturated. Replenish the unit with suitable amounts of the mixed solution as necessary. The diluted solution when mixed as directed contains 5% toxaphene and 0.05% lindane as active ingredients.

NOTE: Be sure oil is free of dirt or other sediment when using mechanically operated equipment. Do not mix Back Scratch Concentrate with used motor oil, crankcase drainings, or greases. Check mechanical equipment before filling to be sure it is operating properly. Reservoirs should be clean; faulty or dirty valves and mechanisms should be cleaned or replaced. Adjust controls so that the oil delivered will be just sufficient to give an oily film to the scratching surface.

WARNING: Avoid contamination of feed, foodstuffs, feeders, waterers, and food equipment. May be fatal if swallowed. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after using.

Do not use for animals less than six months of age or for dairy animals. Do not allow sows to have access to back rubbing equipment for at least 2 weeks before farrowing or 3 weeks after farrowing. Do not allow overheated or sick animals to have access to backrubbing equipment. Do not use within 30 days of slaughter. Do not use as a spray.

This product is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

Do not reuse empty container. Wash thoroughly with water and detergent. Discard in a safe place.

ANTIDOTE: (Humans)—Give one tablespoon of salt in glass of warm water. Repeat until vomit is clear. Call doctor immediately.

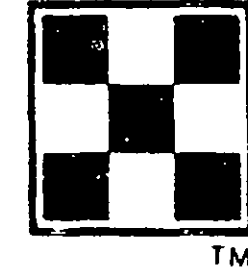

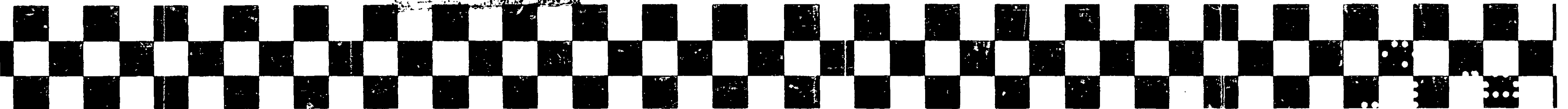
