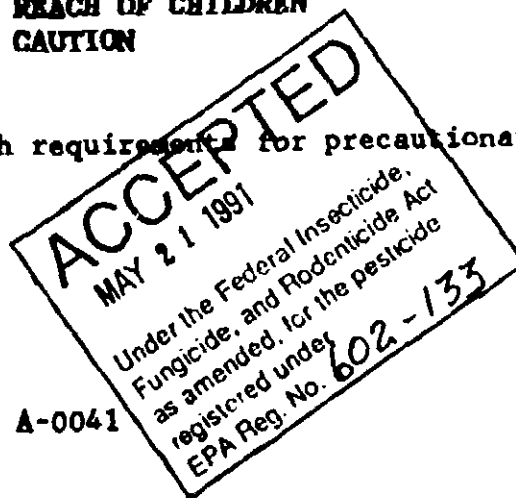

Back PanelDIRECTIONS
