

Purina Egg Rinse is a dry concentrate for use in preparing a sanitizing rinse to washed eggs

HOW TO USE:

Stock Solution. Add 12 cup (8 tablespoonfuls) of Purina Egg Rinse to 1 gallon of water and mix thoroughly

Proportionars: Use a water proportioner which dilutes at the rate of one ounce per gallon and use Stock Solution as the additive. At this rate the eggs will be sanitized with 100 ppm available chlorine

Sanitizing solutions should be slightly warmer than the eggs, but not to exceed 115 F Ideally, the solution should be maintained at 105°F to 115 F
