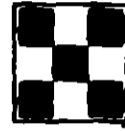

How To Use Purina Crabgrass-Kill

For information on the use of Purina Crabgrass-Kill, see the back panel of the product container. For a complete list of weeds controlled by this herbicide, see the back panel of the product container.

USE DIRECTIONS

HOW TO APPLY: Apply Crabgrass-Kill to lawns and other areas where crabgrass and other grassy weeds are likely to appear. Apply in early spring, before the weeds begin to grow. Apply in a uniform layer over the entire area to be treated. Do not apply to areas where the grass is dormant or where the soil is frozen.

CRABGRASS, DOCKGRASS, WATERGRASS, FORTAL, AND ANNUAL BULLGRASS.
Apply Crabgrass-Kill to lawns and other areas where these weeds are likely to appear. Apply in early spring, before the weeds begin to grow. Apply in a uniform layer over the entire area to be treated. Do not apply to areas where the grass is dormant or where the soil is frozen.

PRECAUTIONS: Do not use Crabgrass-Kill on lawns where the grass is dormant or where the soil is frozen. Do not use Crabgrass-Kill on lawns where the grass is being mowed or where the grass is being fertilized. Do not use Crabgrass-Kill on lawns where the grass is being watered. How To Use Purina Crabgrass-Kill

Purina Crabgrass-Kill is applied directly to established lawns for the control of crabgrass, goosegrass or crowfoot, watergrass or barnyardgrass, yellow and green foxtail and annual bluegrass. Controls grassy weeds by killing seeds as they germinate. Apply before these annual weed seeds begin to germinate, will not control established weeds. When applied as directed, the following established lawn grasses will not be injured: Perennial bluegrass, perennial ryegrass, fescue, centipede, zoysia, bermuda, St. Augustine, and Lantana.

USE DIRECTIONS

WHEN TO APPLY: Apply Crabgrass-Kill in the spring before grassy weeds germinate. Additional applications may be necessary in regions where annual weed grasses germinate in late fall or early summer.

HOW TO APPLY: Determine the correct amount for your lawn area. Set spreader at one-half required rate (Rate in table) in your spreader according to the manufacturer's recommendations. Apply one-half the required amount in one direction and the other half in a crosswise direction. When turning or stopping, close spreader outlet.

CRABGRASS, GOOSEGRASS, WATERGRASS, FOXTAIL AND ANNUAL BLUEGRASS:

Northern (cool season) Lawn Grasses: For pre-emergence seedling control apply 1 bag (10 lbs) for each 8000 sq. ft. of lawn area in the spring prior to annual weed grass germination.

Southern (warm season) Lawn Grasses: For pre-emergence seedling control apply 1 bag (10 lbs) for each 8000 sq. ft. of lawn area in late winter or early spring prior to annual weed grass germination. In the northern or western states where these annual weeds germinate into late summer or early fall, a second application may be made 4 to 6 months after initial treatment for continual weed control.

RESEEDING: Do not reseed for at least 6 weeks in northern areas and for 12 weeks in southern areas after applying Crabgrass-Kill. When reseed, water and fertilize lawn as required. To insure satisfactory reseedling, increase the amount of seed used.

PRECAUTIONS: Crabgrass-Kill may thin established annual bluegrass and fine leaved fescue lawns. Do not apply to lawns planted the previous fall. Do not apply to lawns with grasses under 1/2 inch tall. Do not apply to newly sprouted areas of St. Augustine, or centipede grasses until these lawns are well established.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with skin. Avoid getting on face or clothing. Wash with water. Do not contaminate foodstuffs or feedstuffs. Do not pollute any body of water by direct application, cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes.

Destroy bag when empty, do not reuse.

Approximate Spreader Settings

The settings listed below are intended for use of Crabgrass-Kill at one-half rate as directed above. Check application rate of your spreader before applying. Settings may vary with type, age and condition of spreader.
