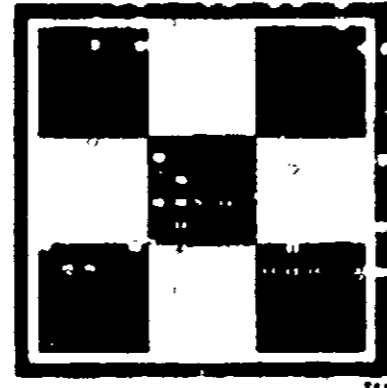

PURINA WEED-KILL GRANULES

Purina Weed-Kill Granules applied before weeds germinate, kills most annual grasses and many broadleaf weeds before they come up. Will not harm established roses, shrubs, trees or flowers listed on side panel. DO NOT APPLY TO ornamental ground covers and unrooted slips or cuttings as injury may result.

Directions For Mixing Into Soil: Remove existing weeds; apply Weed-Kill Granules to soil around established roses; shrubs; trees; and flowers that are 2 to 3 inches or more in height. Apply uniformly at the rate recommended below for soil type. Mix into the soil surface with hand rake being careful not to disturb the roots of plants.

Application Rates For Mixing Weed-Kill Into Soil

One standard measuring cup (tightly packed) equals 1/4 pound.

Note: When applying Weed-Kill Granules to all established plants be sure foliage is dry. Overapplication may cause injury to sensitive seeds planted the following season. Resistant weeds which may appear can be removed by shallow cultivation or hand weeding.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Induce vomiting and call a physician immediately. Avoid contact with skin. Do not contaminate any body of water by direct application, cleaning of equipment or disposal of waste. Do not reuse container; destroy when empty. Do not contaminate or store near feed or foodstuffs.
