



Cleaning - Disinfecting - Deodorizing - Destaining

Food Processing Plants

PURINA Chlorinated Cleaner is a fine crystalline product with stabilized active chlorine.

HOW TO USE:

Cleaning and Disinfecting of Walls, Floors, and Other Porous Surfaces

Thoroughly clean all organic matter by prescraping, presoaking or preflushing from the surface to be disinfected. Then brush or spray, with a high pressure sprayer, a solution of 4 ounces of PURINA Chlorinated Cleaner per gallon of water (provides 1000 ppm of available chlorine) to the surfaces to be disinfected. Allow the surfaces to drain and air dry.

Cleaning and Disinfecting of Utensils and Metal Equipment

Soak, brush or spray a solution of 2 ounces of PURINA Chlorinated Cleaner per gallon of water (provides 500 ppm of available chlorine). If the surface areas are to come in contact with food, rinse with potable water before use.

Sanitizing

Rinse or spray with a solution of 3 ounces (6 tablespoonsful) of PURINA Chlorinated Cleaner in 3-1/2 gallons of water (provides 200 ppm available chlorine). A minimum surface contact time of 1 minute is necessary for PURINA Chlorinated Cleaner to properly sanitize. Allow the solution to drain from the surfaces and air dry. At this level no potable water rinse is required. *permitted*

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep this product in a tightly closed container when not in use. Store in cool, dry, well ventilated area away from heat or open flame. In case of decomposition, isolate container (if possible) and flood area with large amounts of water to dissolve all material before discarding this container in trash collection. Do not contaminate food or feed by storage, disposal, or cleaning of equipment.
