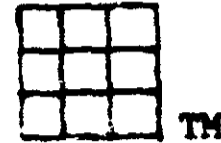

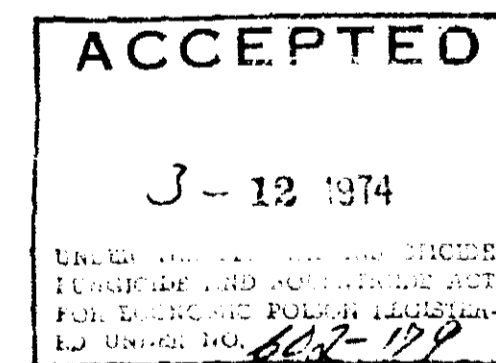

HOW TO USE PURINA FLY-BYE

To Kill and Repel Flies:

Hold container about 12 inches from horse. Apply lightly to entire body surface of horse paying particular attention to the back, belly, neck, face, or leg regions where the specific insect attacking the horse usually feeds. Do not apply to back of horses before they are saddled. Repeat as necessary for continued protection.

Mist directly onto surface wounds, minor cuts, and skin abrasions to keep flies away.

WARNING: Harmful or fatal if swallowed. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call physician immediately.

Avoid wetting the skin of animals.

Flammable! Contents under pressure. Do not use near fire, sparks, or flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.
