PURINA ROACH SPRAY

WARNING—FLAMMABLE! KEEP AWAY FROM HEAT OR OPEN FLAME.

DIRECTIONS: Apply ready to use ROACH SPRAY as a coarse spray to infested surfaces. Prevent excessive wetting of surfaces. Direct spray away from people, plants and pets. ROACH SPRAY kills insects rapidly and for many weeks after the spray deposit has dried.

INDOOR USE: Cockroaches, Ants, Spiders, Crickets, Scorpions, Silverfish: Spray into cracks, crevices, around baseboards and other places where insects hide. Apply behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, and in and around waste containers. For ants, spray trails and places where ants enter premises. Repeat as needed. Do not spray foodstuffs or house plants. Remove pets and cover fish bowls before spraying. Do not allow children to contact treated areas until surfaces are thoroughly dry.

Brown Dog Ticks: Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, and local areas of floors. Repeat as needed. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters after spraying. Do not spray animals.

OUTDOOR USE: Ants, Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Flies, Hornets, Wasps, Millipedes, Sowbugs, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas, Mosquitoes: Spray infested areas thoroughly including outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames, foundations, patios, or other places where insects may enter. For ants, spray hills and runways. For control of hornets and wasps apply after dark when all of insects have returned to the nest. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray vegetation.

CAUTION: May be fatal if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe spray mist. Provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and clothing. Wash thoroughly after using. Avoid contamination of food, utensils and food preparation areas.

Should illness occur, get prompt medical aid.

To Physician—Atropine sulfate is antidotal.

RESTRICTIONS: Do not apply to rugs, carpets, draperies, wallpaper, or similar materials that may be stained. Avoid excessive wetting of plastic, rubber and asphalt surfaces such as tiles and floor coverings. Plastic sprayers may be damaged if allowed to remain in ROACH SPRAY solution.

Do not use in commercial food preparation areas or in edible products areas of food processing plants.

Do not use empty bottle. Destroy bottle by breaking and bury or discard in a safe place.

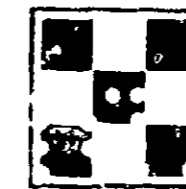
