

HOW TO USE PURINA CATTLE DUST

Dust livestock in the spring when hornflies first appear to prevent rapid increase in number of flies.

DIRECTIONS:

Milk Cows—Sprinkle Cattle Dust over the shoulders and back. Rub dust lightly into the haircoat. Use one pound to 10 animals. Treat every 3 weeks, if necessary, for best hornfly control.


Calves and Heifers—Sprinkle Cattle Dust over shoulders, back and sides. Rub lightly into the haircoat. Use one pound to 15-30 animals, depending on size. Treat as often as necessary for best hornfly control.

Beef Cattle—Sprinkle Cattle Dust over shoulders, back and sides. Work thorough application into the hair coat. Treat as often as necessary for best hornfly control.

CAUTION: Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Protect milk and milking equipment from contamination. Do not inhale.


