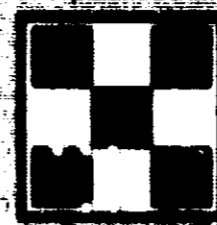

HOW TO USE PURINA FACE AND HORSEFLY BOMB

FACE FLIES: Remove any mucous secretions or saliva deposits from face of animal. Spray face region and other body regions where face flies gather lightly—4 to 5 seconds per head. Pay particular attention to the areas around the eyes and nostrils. Treat dairy cattle daily, preferably while they are stanchioned for morning milking.

For temporary protection of dairy cattle, beef cattle, and horses from horse flies, horn flies, stable flies, deer flies, house flies, mosquitoes, and gnats. Hold container 12 inches from animal. Apply lightly to hair coat with a sweeping motion. Apply to back, belly, ear, or leg regions where the specific insect attacking the animal usually feeds. Do not spray entire body area. Spray young animals sparingly. Do not apply to back of horses before they are saddled. Repeat as necessary for continued protection. Avoid wetting hide.

CAUTION: Harmful or fatal if swallowed. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call physician immediately.

Do not contaminate milk or milk handling equipment. Do not spray or store near heat or open flame.

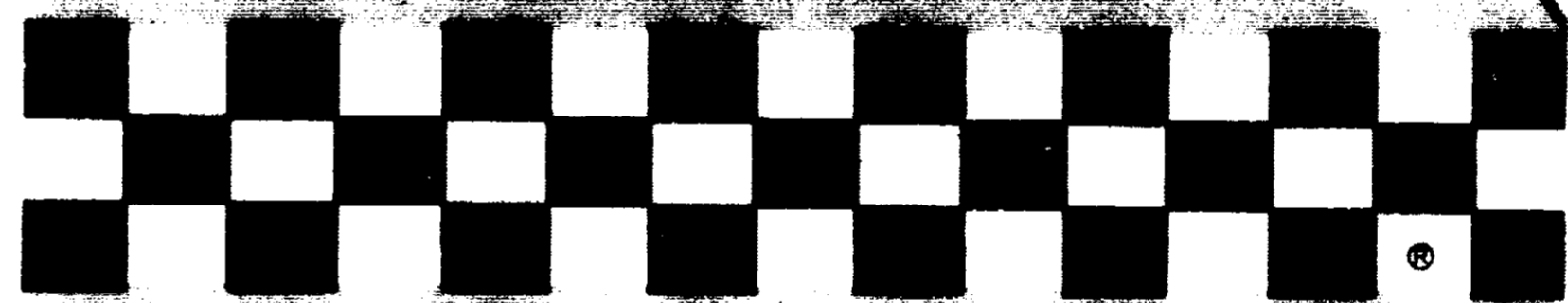
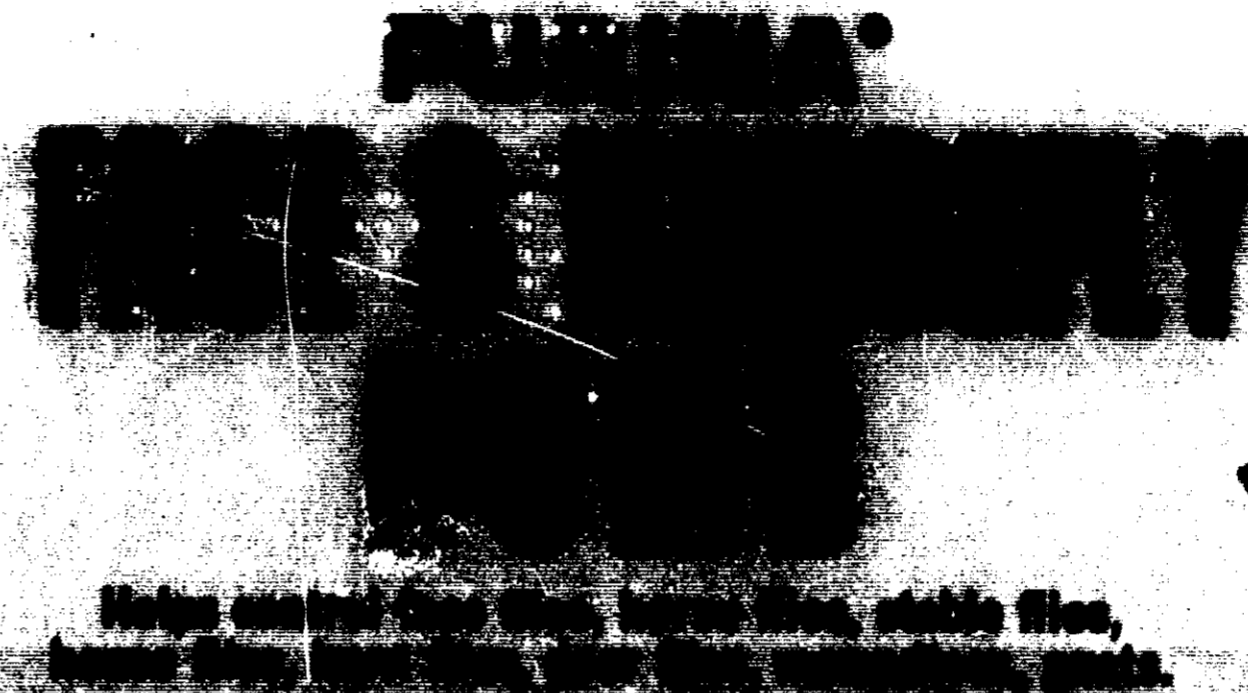
