

## PURINA YARD & PATIO INSECT FOGGER DIRECTIONS

**SHAKE BEFORE USE.** Point valve opening away from face and angled slightly downward. For best results use when air is calm or breeze is slight.

**Flying Insects:** (Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Moths) Spray with the breeze; allow fog to drift over area to be protected. When treating grass or bushes stand at least 4 to 6 feet away; drift spray on to areas to be protected. Repeat as necessary.

**Crawling Insects:** (Ants, Crickets, Centipedes) Spray infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Spray legs of tables and chairs to repel crawling insects. Spray ant hills and trails thoroughly for best control.

**Wasps and Hornets:** Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Repeat as necessary.

**CAUTION:** Avoid inhalation and skin contact. Cover exposed food. Do not apply to food crops or on household pets. Do not contaminate fish ponds. Keep 4 to 6 feet away from ornamental plants while spraying. Not for indoor use.

**WARNING:** Flammable! Contents under pressure. Do not use near fire, sparks, or flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F may cause bursting.
