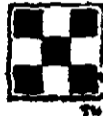

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS  
HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS  
CAUTION

May cause irritation of nose and throat. Avoid breathing of dust. Use a dust mask in confined areas to prevent inhalation. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. May be absorbed through skin. Do not apply with bare hand. Use dust mitt or other protective glove. Wash thoroughly after handling. Harmful if swallowed.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

- If Swallowed: Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention.
- If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply respiration if indicated.
- If On Skin: Wash contaminated skin with soap and water.
- If In Eyes: Flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention immediately.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This pesticide is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Use with care when applying in areas adjacent to any body of water. Keep out of lakes, streams and ponds. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE

For application only by or under the direct supervision of a certified applicator.

Applicators must wear the following protective clothing during the application process: a light-weight protective suit or coveralls; water-resistant hat; unlined, waterproof gloves; and unlined, light-weight boots. Mixers and loaders must also wear goggles or a face shield, waterproof gloves and a waterproof apron.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

TO KILL LICE, FLEAS AND TO AID IN PREVENTING THE SPREAD OF SARCOPTIC MANGE ON PIGS: Rub Hog Dust into the hair coat of all animals of the herd. Dust animals thoroughly. Repeat at monthly intervals if additional applications are necessary.

TO AID IN CONTROLLING FLEAS AND LICE: Remove soiled bedding or litter and scatter Hog Dust at the rate of 1 lb per 100 square feet on floor or ground area. Provide clean bedding or litter. Scatter Hog Dust on the bedding occasionally (1/2 lb per 100 square feet) as a preventive measure against insects.

Do not treat sows within 2 weeks of farrowing or for 3 weeks after farrowing. Do not treat animals less than 3 months old. Do not treat animals within 30 days of slaughter. Keep animals off treated bedding for at least 30 days prior to slaughter. Avoid treating overheated or sick animals.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture, or rinsate is a violation of federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

Container Disposal: Completely empty bag into application equipment. Then dispose of empty bag in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or, if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. A Symptoms of Poisoning section must be added to the label in close proximity to the STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT; we suggest the following:

"SYMPTOMS OF POISONING: headache, nausea, dizziness, loss of equilibrium, muscle spasms, difficulty in breathing, hyper-excitability and convulsions."

2. The "If swallowed" STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT is inadequate; please use the following:

"If swallowed—Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person."

3. Change "HAZARD TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS" to "HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS". The way the heading presently reads, it would suggest only one hazard.

(Underscoring added to highlight revision; please do not reproduce on the label.)

4. Note that the type size requirement for the heading "RESTRICTED USE PESTICIDE" is the same as required for the front panel signal word.

5. Revise the following statement appearing under "HAZARUS TO HUMANS...":

"Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or snoking."

(Underscore indicates added text; please do not reproduce underscore on the label.)

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until April 1, 1984. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the Existing Stocks provisions stated in our letter of October 28, 1983.
