DIRECTIONS:

- Lawn-se Beetle Larvae  
2 1/2 oz. per thousand square feet
- Grasshoppers and Lawn Moths, Cutworms,  
Saw Flies, Pill Bugs,  
6 oz. per thousand square feet
- Wire Worms  
6 1/2 oz. per thousand on loam or clay,  
10 1/2 oz. per thousand square feet on  
silt or peat.
- Cornbugs, Crickets, and Earwigs,  
Wire Worms  
6 oz. per thousand square feet.

GRASS-CIDE should be mixed with sufficient water  
as indicated in directions before application.  
GRASS-CIDE can be used through hose-end sprayers.

CAUTION:
