DIRECTIONS

Use one quart to ten gallons of water; one gallon to 40 gallons of water. One quart makes enough for 200 square feet; one gallon for 800 square feet; five gallons for 4,000 square feet or more. Apply with sprinkler or watering-pot. Vessels used in applying must be thoroughly washed out after using, as the Weed Killer is a poison. If the ground is very dry, first wet with clear water, so the Weed Killer will not sink away too quickly. This Weed Killer kills Poison Ivy or Sumach, as well as ordinary weeds. For best results apply anytime when ground is not frozen. Not for lawns.
