
DIRECTIONS (Continued)

Valuable in cage layer opera-' tions by sprinkling in the alleys and under cages.

The number of applications per week is entirely dependent upon the fly population. It is important to always have the bait present in areas frequented by flies for constant control. Avoid sprinkling in litter and other places where it may sift away out of reach of flies

CAUTION: Induce vomiting if swallowed. Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin, wash thoroughly after using. Do not use inside homes. Do not contaminate milk, milk-handling equip ment, feed or drinking water. If poisoning should occur, call a physician at once. Atropine is antidetal



DIRECTIONS

Use as a dry sprinkle fly bait as it comes from can, or dissolve 1 lb. in 1,2 gallon of water and use as a syrup. The syrup may be used in a sprinkler can or pieces of burlap may be saturated and hung up in areas frequented by flies. Make up only that amount of syrup needed for immediate use. Use wherever flies congregate, in all livestock buildings including dairy barns and milk rooms, poultry houses, around garbage cans, dumps, and outside of human dwellings, restaurants, drive-ins, ice cream stands, dog kennels etc. Sprinkle lightly either wet or dry on exposed surfaces such as floors walkways. alleyways ata Use about 1.1 lb. per 1000 square feet of floor area
