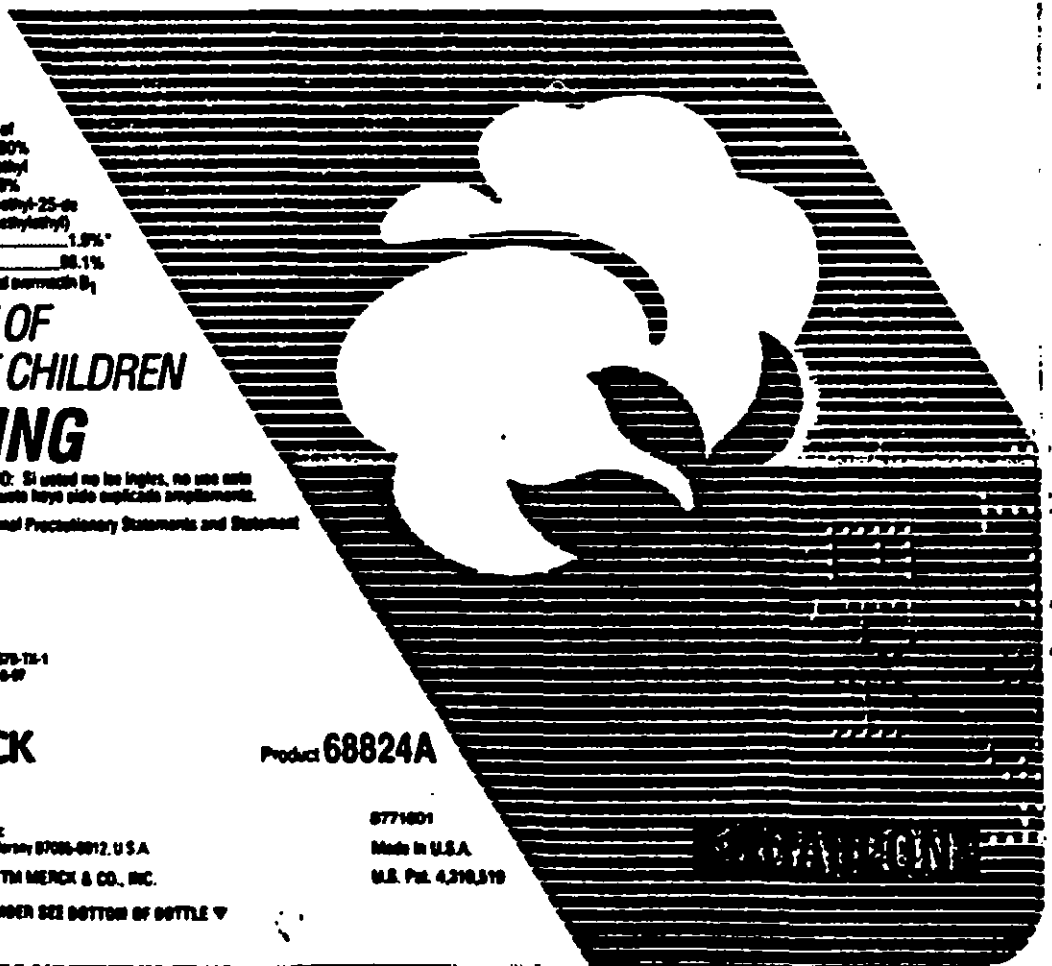

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS  
WARNING**

Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Do not get in eyes or on clothing. Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe spray mist. May be fatal if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin. Wear protective clothing including long sleeve shirt, long trousers, rubber gloves, and goggles or face shield when mixing and loading. During spray application, wear long sleeve shirt, long trousers, and rubber gloves. Remove any contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling, before eating, drinking or using tobacco. Do not apply this product in such a manner as to directly or through drift expose workers or other persons. The area being treated must be vacated by unprotected persons.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

**If inhaled:** Remove victim to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.  
**If swallowed:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by gently touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.  
**If on skin:** Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.  
**If in eyes:** Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

**Recommendations for Medical Treatment for Avermectin B, Acute Toxicity:**

Early signs of intoxication include mydriasis (dilated pupils), ataxia (unsteadiness) and muscle tremors. Toxicity following accidental ingestion of the concentrate can be minimized by inducing vomiting within one half hour of exposure.

If toxicity from exposure has progressed to cause severe vomiting, the extent of resultant fluid and electrolyte imbalance should be gauged. Appropriate supportive parenteral fluid replacement therapy should be given, along with other required supportive measures (such as maintenance of blood pressure levels) as indicated by clinical signs, symptoms and measurements.

In severe cases, observations should continue for at least several days until clinical condition is stable and normal. Since avermectin B, is believed to enhance GABA activity in animals, it is probably wise to avoid drugs that enhance GABA activity (barbiturates, benzodiazepines, valproic acid) in patients with potentially toxic avermectin B, exposure.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This pesticide is toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from target areas. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment, wash water, or rinsate.

This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or residues on blooming crops or weeds. Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds if bees are visiting the treatment area.

**REENTRY STATEMENT**

Do not reenter treated areas until sprays have dried.

**PHYSICAL/CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal (U.S.A.) law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**COTTON:** ZEPHYR® 0.15 EC is an emulsifiable concentrate containing 0.15 lb avermectin B, per gallon which, when mixed with water according to the Directions for Use, will control Spider mites (twospotted, carmine, Pacific and Strawberry) on cotton.

For control of spider mites on cotton, mix with water and apply at the rates given in the following table:

Spider Mites	Fluid Ounces Per Acre	
	Mid season/Lay-by	Early Season (California only)
Twospotted Carmine Pacific Strawberry	8 - 16	4 - 8

Use 8 - 16 fl oz ZEPHYR per acre depending on size of the plant and density of the foliage. Apply with ground sprayers or aerially by fixed-wing aircraft or helicopter in a minimum of 5 gallons of water per acre to provide thorough coverage. Begin application when mites are first noticed and repeat if necessary.

For use on early season cotton within the state of California, apply prior to June 15 on cotton under 10 inches in height. Apply at a rate of 4 - 6 fl oz ZEPHYR per acre by ground equipment only.

**USE RESTRICTIONS**

- Do not apply more than 32 fl oz or more than two applications of ZEPHYR per acre in any growing season.
- Do not apply within 21 days of last treatment.
- Do not apply this product east of the Mississippi River.
- Do not apply within 20 days of harvest.
- Do not graze or feed cotton foliage.
- Do not apply this product through any type of irrigation system.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL**

**Storage:** Store in a tightly closed container in a cool, dry place.

**Prohibitions:** Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited. Do not reuse empty container.

**Pesticide Disposal:** Pesticide spray mixture or rinsate that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides or buried in a safe place away from water supplies. Improper disposal of excess pesticide spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal (U.S.A.) law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by the user according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.
