Delete the crossed-out statements on your proposed label. They are redundant statements or phrases.



CITRUS: AGRI-MEK® 0.15 EC is an emulsifiable concentrate which will control citrus rust mile, broad mile, and twospotted spider mite when applied according to the Directions for Use. Apply using conventional dilute or concentrate ground sprayers calibrated to deliver sufficient water for thorough coverage. Gallonage of spray will vary with size and number of trees per acre and density of foliage. In any case, thorough coverage is essential for good mite control. Applications should be made with parafinic spray oil as indicated in the chart.


