PHENOL COEFFICIENT 6

Contents 1 Gallon

ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

Coal Tar Neutral Oils
Anhydrous Soap
Coal Tar Acids
Water

INERT INGREDIENT: 10%

A germicide for use as a DISINFECTANT, CLEANER, DEGREASER and DEODORIZER.
DIRECTIONS

Dilute 1 ounce of KOLTAROL DISINFECTANT in 3 quarts of water. Before using the disinfectant remove all filth and dirt deposits from building or object to be disinfected.

FOR FARM BUILDINGS remove all livestock or poultry from buildings to be treated with the disinfectant. Thoroughly clean and protect or remove from the building all equipment including feeders and waterers. Remove all litter or bedding and clean building thoroughly. Apply disinfectant only at the recommended rate. When feeding and watering equipment is disinfected, rinse equipment thoroughly with potable water. Ventilate building and do not house livestock or poultry until treatment has been absorbed, set or dried.

Not for use in Milk Room or Milking Parlor.

FOR SEED POTATO storage bins, equipment, crates, barrels and bags. Apply 1 part KOLTAROL DISINFECTANT in 80 parts warm water as wash or spray. Dip crates and barrels in solution. Soak used bags for one hour, 250 bags per 10 gallons of solution.

Do not use in areas or on equipment for edible potatoes.

FOR DEGREASING engines, gears, tools and garage floors brush on KOLTAROL DISINFECTANT, allow to soak 15-30 minutes and wash off with tap water or hose. Repeat as necessary.

WARNING: Keep out of Reach of Children

May be fatal if swallowed or absorbed through skin. May produce severe burns. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothes. Avoid breathing spray mist. Wash thoroughly after handling.

FIRST AID: In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed, drink PROMPTLY a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression and convulsion may be needed.
