A fragrant cleaner and disinfectant for homes, boats, apartments, hotels, motels, office buildings, schools and other public buildings.

DIRECTIONS

As a general cleaner and disinfectant use $\frac{1}{2}$ cup (4 fl. oz.) per gallon of warm water. Apply so as to wet surfaces thoroughly. One or two cups full into the diaper pail will sweeten and condition the diapers for laundry. For the dogs bath use two tablespoons full per gallon of water.

For handyman degreasing and paint brush cleaning use cleaner straight from the container, soak as necessary then rinse.

Also, a cup full now and then into the sink drains overnight will keep them greasefree, sanitary and sweet.
