Pour recommended amount of this material through screen on surface of water in nearly filled spray tank, or pre-mix in a bucket half filled with water and pour into nearly filled spray tank. Add balance of water to fill tank. Keep agitator running during filling, mixing, and spraying operations. Do not allow mixture to stand. Do not use in low volume gear-type spray equipment. Do not combine wettable powders with emulsifiable liquids in the same spray tank unless previous use of the materials being combined has proved them to be physically compatible. PEAR & APPLE: Aphids - Use 1, to 3 ibs in 100 gals, water. May be used as late as petal fall at the 2 lb. dosage for the control of Rosy Apple Aphids. Do not apply more than 12 lbs, per acre application. Do not apply within 60 days of harvest, or after the fruit starts to form.

PEACH: Plum Curculia - Use (to 2 lbs. in 100 gals. water. Do not apply more than 8 lbs. per acre application.
