CAUTION

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If **swallowed**, call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. **DO NOT INDUCE VOMITING.** Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.

If **inhaled**, remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If **on skin**, remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If **in eyes**, flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Solvent presents aspiration hazard. Gastric lavage may be indicated if material was taken internally. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered in conjunction with atropine.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Birds feeding in treated areas may be killed. Do not apply directly to water. Do not apply when weather conditions favor drift from treated areas. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in original container only, preferably in a locked area. Keep container tightly closed when not in use. Store in a cool, dry place. Do not use food or drink containers for mixing or storage.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash.

DIRECTIONS

Use only the trigger sprayer supplied with this product. Adjust sprayer to deliver coarse spray for surface spraying. Use pinstream spray for cracks and crevices.

Spray infested surfaces only until wet. Do not make puddles or runoff.

Do not apply to rugs, carpets, drapery or wallpaper if they may be stained. Avoid application to plastic or rubber articles that may be affected by this spray. Test an inconspicuous area before making full treatment.

ROACHES, ANTS, WATERBUGS, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, CRICKETS: Spray into all cracks, around baseboards and other places where these insects hide. Spray only until wet. Also spray until wet, surfaces behind and beneath cabinets, refrigerators, sinks, stoves, etc. For ants, spray inside window frames and door sills where ant trails are seen. Spray other localized areas infested with these pests. Repeat treatment as required.

CARPET BEETLES: Make localized application to areas of the floor and baseboards. Spray directly into cracks and under carpets where insects may be found. Spray only until wet. Treat crevices, cracks or closets and infested areas of shelvings. Repeat as necessary.

BROWN DOG TICKS: Spray infested areas around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks, sleeping quarters of household pets and localized areas of floors and floor coverings. Spray only until wet. Applications should be repeated as infestations warrant and as re-infestations occur. Fresh bedding should be placed in animal quarters following treatment. Do not treat animals with this formulation.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, WASPS AND FLYING MOTHS OUTDOORS: For outdoor use around homes and buildings only as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of screens, doors, window frames or wherever these insects may enter the room. Also treat surfaces around light fixtures on porches, in garages, and other places where these insects alight or congregate.

NOTE: Use as a surface spray only. This product should not be sprayed into the air to control flying insects. Use a product registered for flying insect control.

FLEAS, CHIGGERS, ANTS, AND BROWN DOG TICKS OUTDOORS: For treatment of localized infestations of these insects in outdoor areas around homes and buildings where there is no vegetation, spray infested areas thoroughly. For ants, thoroughly wet hills and runways. Repeat applications as infestations warrant and as re-infestations occur. If vegetation is sprayed, plant injury or loss may occur.

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
