### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

**CABBAGE LETTUCE BROCCOLI BRUSSELS SPROUT** - Apply as a spray to the undersides of leaves. Use 2 to 4 quarts per acre. Repeat applications every 7 to 10 days. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.

**TOMATOES** - Apply as a spray to the undersides of leaves. Use 2 to 4 quarts per acre. Repeat applications every 7 to 10 days. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.

**BEANS** - Apply as a spray to the undersides of leaves. Use 2 to 4 quarts per acre. Repeat applications every 7 to 10 days. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.

**COTTON** - Apply as a spray to the undersides of leaves. Use 2 to 4 quarts per acre. Repeat applications every 7 to 10 days. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest.

**NOTICE** - This product is a restricted use pesticide. Only persons certified by the EPA may apply it.

May Be Fatal if Swallowed, Inhaled, or Absorbed Through Skin. Rapidly Absorbed Through Skin. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear natural rubber gloves, protective clothing and goggles. In case of contact, wash immediately with copious amounts of water. When a mask or respirator of a type listed by the U.S. Department of Agriculture is worn for protection, keep all unprotected persons out of the treated area until the insecticide has been completely washed away.

Do not use if you are pregnant or nursing, or if you are planning to become pregnant. Do not use if you are allergic to any of the ingredients. Do not use if you have asthma or other respiratory conditions. Do not use if you have a known allergy to any of the ingredients. Do not use if you are taking any medication.

Do not use in residential areas. Do not use in areas where children or pets may be present. Do not use in areas where water is used for drinking or cooking.

### FIRST AID TREATMENT

**INGESTION** - Do not induce vomiting. Give water to drink. Seek medical attention immediately.

**INTERNAL** - If swallowed, give water to drink. Do not induce vomiting. Seek medical attention immediately.

**SKIN** - Wash immediately with copious amounts of water. Remove contaminated clothing. Seek medical attention if irritation persists.

**EYES** - Flush immediately with copious amounts of water. Seek medical attention immediately.

NEVER GIVE ANYTHING BY MOUTH TO AN ILL PERSON.

**PHYSICIANS NOTE:** Warning symptoms include weakness, headache, tightness in the chest, difficulty breathing, reactive pinpoint pupils, salivation, slow and irregular pulse, vomiting, diarrhea, and abdominal cramps.

**TREATMENT:** Give at least one of the following antidotes: 1. Two or three tablets of atropine and pyridostigmine bromide (2-PAM) as an antidote and may be administered in conjunction with atropine. However, give morphine or clear chest physostigmine if needed. Antidote administration of oxygen administration may be given as needed. Start treatment with 4 mg of atropine. Repeat exposure to the insecticide may occur. Wash with water. Warn of the insecticide's toxicity. Do not use antidotes if the insecticide is not a cholinesterase inhibitor. Do not use antidotes if the insecticide is a carbamate.

NOT for USE or STORAGE in the HOME.

Highly toxic to fish and wildlife. Do not contaminate any body of water nor apply to any area not specified on the label. Bird feeding on treated areas may be killed. Do not apply where runoff is likely to occur. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment, or disposal of waste.

If you or your family are exposed to the insecticide, call your doctor immediately. Do not use if you are allergic to any of the ingredients.

**DECONTAMINATION AND DISPOSAL INSTRUCTIONS** - Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water. Wash clothing and other items that have been in contact with the insecticide. Do not use or dispose of contaminated items in the home. Dispose of containers in accordance with the label.
