ACMEPINE 5 is manufactured from Pure Steam Distilled Pine Oil and Vegetable Oil Soap which makes it instantly soluble in water. It forms a creamy milk-white emulsion which does not separate on standing. It is non-corrosive, non-caustic, and when mixed with water in recommended dilutions, will not stain walls, floors, clothes, etc. **ACMEPINE 5** leaves a pleasant pine odor.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FLOORS: When mopping or scrubbing use 1½ ounces of **ACMEPINE 5** to each gallon of water in the bucket.

GENERAL PREMISE DISINFECTING: Remove all filth and dirt from the premises and use a solution of one part of **ACMEPINE 5** to 100 parts of water. This mixture acts as a disinfectant against *S. typhosa*.

TOILETS, URINALS, SHOWER STALLS, BATHTUBS, FLOORS, ETC.: Flush the toilet bowls and urinals regularly with ½ cup of **ACMEPINE 5** in each gallon of water, leaving the disinfectant in the bowls as long as possible. Scrub the floors and seats frequently with this solution.

GARBAGE: To aid in preventing the breeding of flies and certain other insects, sprinkle with the solution in the proportion of 1½ ounces of **ACMEPINE 5** to each gallon of water. Raise the empty can with some of the solution and leave the wash in the can. In a typhoid sick-room, in the disinfecting of beds, clothes, utensils, room surfaces; the sanitary removal of typhoid stools, and the sanitizing of the hands of those attending typhoid patients, **ACMEPINE 5** should be used in the proportion of three ounces in each gallon of water.

The following table will assist in obtaining accurate dilutions:

1½ ounces with 1 gallon makes 1% solution
2½ ounces with 1 gallon makes 2% solution
4 ounces with 1 gallon makes 3% solution
6½ ounces with 1 gallon makes 5% solution

DIRECTIONS for USE

As a DISINFECTANT:

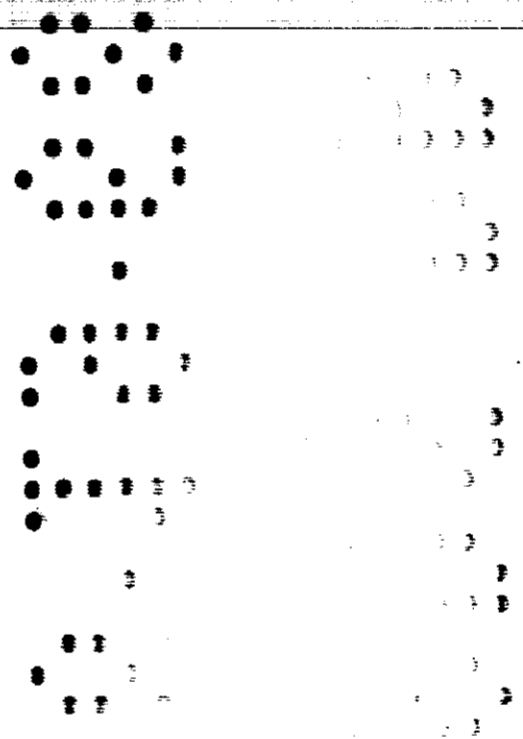
